


## How to access ebooks

Dear students,

In order to find ebooks, please search any title via the library catalogue (Flora).

Please login here with your ESCP username and password:

- On the left bar click: "Catalogue" and after "Babylone Catalogue"
- Select: "All libraries" and in Document type: "eBook"

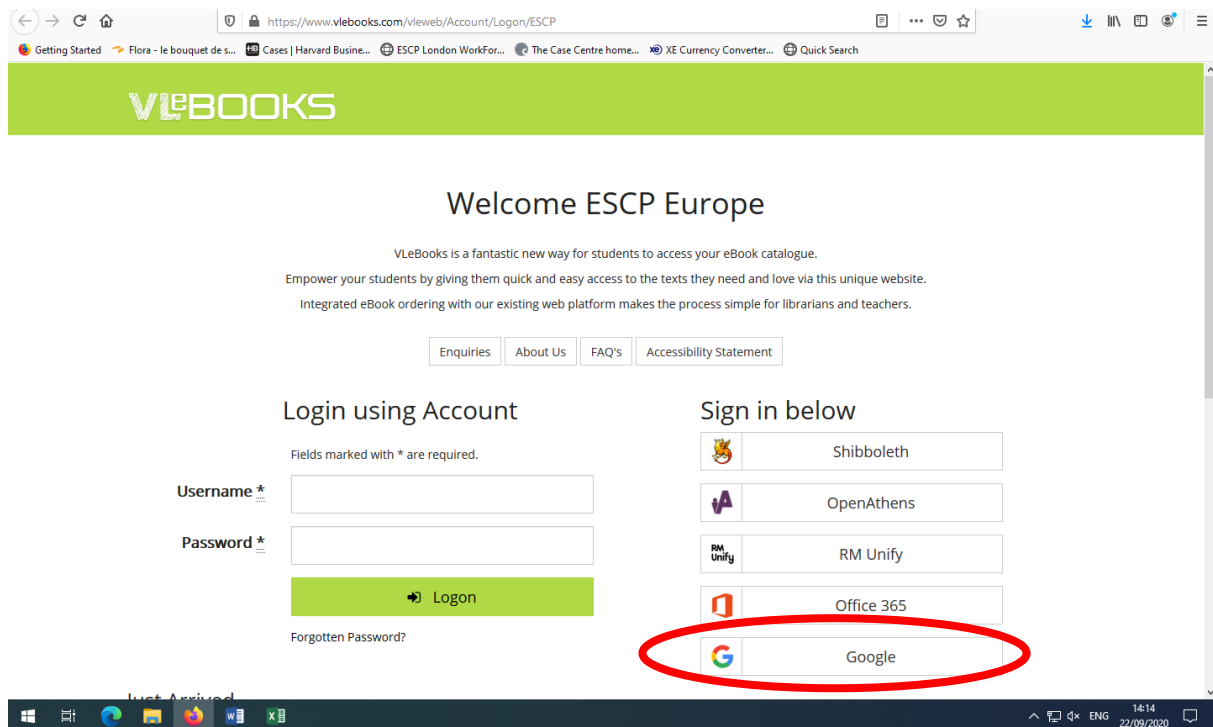
